Sign up for emergency notifications and alerts for your local area



For Your Electric Vehicle & On the Road



Keep your **vehicle** charged to 100% as much as possible.



Plan your **exit route** and **identify charging locations** ahead of time.



Ensure your **charging payment method** is up-to-date in the app you will be using.



Make sure you have your **charging adapter** and that it **stays with you** and your vehicle.

For Your Home Bi-Directional Charging System



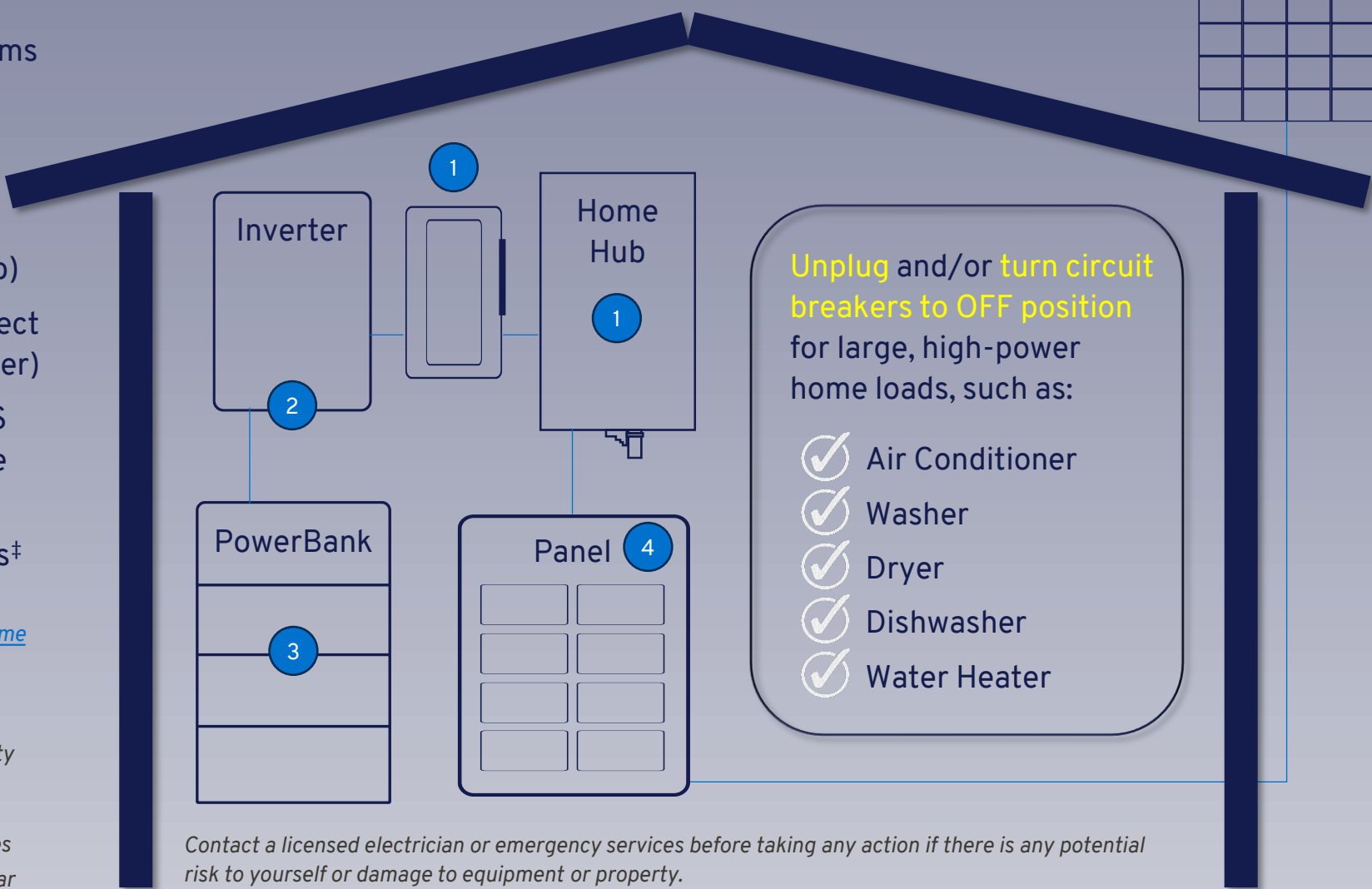
Turn the following items to the **OFF position***:

- 1) AC disconnect† and/or Inverter circuit breaker (inside Home Hub)
- 2) DC solar disconnect (bottom of Inverter)
- 3) PowerBank / ESS breaker(s) (inside PowerBank(s))
- 4) AC solar breakers‡

‡ solar breaker location varies based on specific home solar installation
